Objectives of the Course

The main objectives of the course are to:

- 1. develop the skill of aural recognition of rhythmic patterns and intervals (melodic, harmonic)
- 2. promote the ability to cope with melodic dictation (single voice)
- 3. develop the ability to sight-sing through simple diatonic, single-key, exercises.

Learning Outcomes

After completion of the course students are expected to be able to:

- 1. Identify rhythmic patterns
- 2. Identify intervals
- 3. Name by listening the quality of triads (major, minor, augmented and diminished)
- 4. Sing melodic patterns (single voice)
- 5. Sing scales (major, minor) and broken chords in all inversions
- 6. Write one part melodic dictation

- Elementary rhythmic patterns
- Intervals (diatonic, chromatic)
- Short diatonic melodies
- Major and minor (melodic, harmonic, natural) scales
- Chords (major, minor, augmented and diminished) in all inversions
