Course Objectives:

The main objectives of the course are to:

- Develop foundational listening skills geared towards academic settings.
- Enhance the students' ability to summarize, paraphrase, and cite information accurately.
- Introduce students to the concept of cultural context in communication.
- Encourage active participation in class discussions based on the readings as well as independent research in print and electronic media, and the productive use of AI.

- Demonstrate skills in summarizing, paraphrasing, and citing information accurately.

- Encourage active participation in class discussions based on the readings and orally presenting work to peers.



Course Content:

1. Reading Fundamentals

- a. Identifying main ideas, themes, and supporting details
- b. Understanding the structure of academic texts
- c. Strategies for skimming and scanning

2. Vocabulary Building for Reading

- Identifying and understanding the use of academic vocabulary in texts
- b. Contextual vocabulary exercises
- c. Vocabulary tests focused on readings

3. Basic Listening Skills

- a. Identifying main points in academic lectures or discussions
- b. Note-taking strategies during listening activities
- c. Exercises on listening for specific information.

4. Introduction to Summarizing and Paraphrasing

- a. Techniques for summarizing information from both written and oral sources
- b. Guidelines for paraphrasing effectively
- c. Exercises on integrating summaries and paraphrases into academic writing

5. Cultural Context in Reading

- a. Understanding the influence of culture on language and communication
- b. Analysis of texts from various cultural backgrounds
- c. Class discussions on cultural themes

6. Basic Research Skills

- Introduction to academic databases
- b. Strategies for effective online searching
- c. Summarizing and citing sources in academic writing

7. Interactive Reading, Listening and Speaking Exercises

- a. Group activities centered around reading, listening, and speaking tasks
- b. Presentation of work in class with peer evaluations
- c. Discussions of scholarly texts, as well as recorded public presentations such as specialised TEDx talks
